## I. Public Hearing: CDBG FY 2004 Business Assistance Program Application to DECD for Maine Monolite at 2 Town Landing Road #12

Al Smith, Community Development Coordinator, explained the details of the application for the grant and introduced Anthony Burich, Managing Member of Monolite. Mr. Burich spoke to the group regarding the Maine Monolite project. He stated that the product would be exclusive to Maine and any companies that would want to use the product would never be able to use it for production outside the State. The development portion of the company would be based in Bath, the product would be extremely usable in many other manufacturing endeavors and the company would be employee owned and operated. Mr. Burich introduced Stephen Lardie of J.J. McMullen Associates. Mr. Lardie explained that they would be supporting this project by providing technical/engineering services. Next, Mr. Burich introduced Dr. Vince Caccese, P.E., PhD., Director of the Crosby Laboratory, University of Maine/Orono. Dr. Caccese stated that the University would provide technical data, assist with testing of materials to ensure products work correctly and help with designing.

Numerous Councilors spoke in complete support of this project and were anxious to see it brought to fruition.

Is authorized and directed to submit a Community Development Block Grant Business Assistance Application to the Department of Economic and Community Development on behalf of Maine Monolite, LLC to assist in the establishment a composite Manufacturing facility and the creation of new employment opportunities, substantially in the form presented to this Council;

2. Is authorized to make such assurances on behalf of the City of Bath required as part of such applications; and

3. Is authorized and directed, upon acceptance of said funds to carry out the duties and responsibilities for implementing said program(s), consistent with the Charter of the City of Bath and the laws and regulations governing planning and implementation of community development programs in the State of Maine.
