

ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING MINUTES

- I. City Clerk White called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM.
- II. Acting City Manager Mateosian gave the introduction of the Bath City Councilors.

Councilor Ward 4 - Bernard Wyman, Jr. (11 years completed, commencing year 3 of a 3-year term)
Councilor Ward 5 – John Hart, Jr. (4 year completed, commencing year 2 of a 3-year term)
Councilor Ward 6 – Brian Verville (commencing year 1 of a 3-year term)
Councilor Ward 7 – Ruthe Pagurko (commencing year 1 of a 3-year term)
Councilor At Large – Andrew Winglass (3 years completed [Ward 1 Councilor], commencing year 1 of a 3-year term [At Large])

City Solicitor Therriault gave the oath of office to the newly elected Councilors.

- III. City Clerk White put nominations for the position of Council Chairman on the floor. Councilor Quimby nominated Councilor Bernard Wyman for the position of Chairman, with a second from Councilor Hart. Seeing no other nominations, Councilor Hart motioned that nominations cease and the City Clerk cast a unanimous ballot for Councilor Wyman to serve as Chairman until the first Wednesday and December 2006. The motion was seconded by Councilor Blake. City Clerk White asked Chairman Wyman to take his seat up front.
- IV. Chairman Wyman made a brief statement of thanks to fellow Councilors for their vote of confidence. Chairman Wyman asked for nominations for the position of Vice-Chairman of the City Council. The nomination of Councilor Andrew Winglass for the position of Vice-Chairman was made by Councilor Quimby, seconded by Councilor Hart. Chairman Wyman asked for any other nominations. Seeing none, Councilor Quimby asked that nominations cease Chairman Wyman asked for any other nominations. Seeing none, Councilor Quimby motioned that nominations cease. The motion was seconded by Councilor Pagurko. Chairman Wyman asked for a raising of hands for Councilor Winglass as Vice Chairman to serve until the first Wednesday of December 2006. The vote was unanimous.

V. Chairman Wyman then introduced Reverend Michael Ambler of the Grace Episcopal Church offered the Invocation.

The Organizational Meeting concluded at 7:42 PM and the Council went directly into the Regular Meeting.
