List of Hazardous Intersections/Roadways for Bicycle Drivers (with some recommendations)

- 1.Crawford/Oak Grove intersection has visibility issues
- 2. Oak Grove/Whiskeag intersection should be roundabout or T intersection. Also, have dashed road markings showing where main road goes (like the dashed line added to where Rte 209 and Parker Head road T down by Popham Beach).
- 3. Oak Grove at Five Corners more dashed lines following Oak Grove.
- 4. Center St three-way stop and stop signs by Mae's Cafe and Court Street. Have engineer experienced in bike/ped designs make suggestions
- 5. Rte 209 make sure any changes by State are bike/ped friendly
