Bike/Ped Meeting Minutes for November 18, 2015

Meeting called to order at 3:04 pm.

Present: Kevin Shute - Chairman, Travis Wolfel, Peter Owen, Robert McChesney, John Swenson, Steve Balboni, Maria Newcomb.

- 1. October meeting minutes were accepted.
- 2. Peter reported that Old Bath Road and Whiskeag Road are paved and should be striped as soon as a contractor can be contracted to do the work.
- 3. There was an update on MDOT's plans to replace the deck on the Congress Avenue Bridge in 2017. There is concern that the state does not plan to add a sidewalk to the current bridge. The city intends to press for a new sidewalk. The committee is urged to show up at public meeting to press this issue.
- 4. Peter provided a handout that presented the current inventory of sidewalks that were rated some time ago. The rating s represents sidewalks that should be either reconstructed or where a new sidewalk should go. It has been some time since a sidewalk condition rating has been conducted and Peter asked for help from the committee. Peter will send out a guideline for rating sidewalk conditions. Once completed the committee can the rate the priority of which sidewalks get improvements as funding becomes available.
- 5. Waterfront walkway Steve reported that Wright-Pierce Consultants has been hired by the city to begin a conceptual layout plan of a river front walkway. There are many steps still to be planned such as meeting with the Maine DEP to determine what limitations exists to construct a walkway along the river.
- 6. Kevin inquired about a sidewalk in the vicinity of Walgreens and Peter deferred to Andrew who was not present.
- 7. Robert handed out a letter of recommendation he drafted that is intended to come from the bike/ped committee and be addressed to the Bath City Council. The recommendation is a request to the council to fund road edge lines for city streets in order to make them safer. Robert also provided a table of streets that would receive edge lines on a regular basis. In general the committee liked the language.

Peter requested that language be added to include a phrase to "add funding" to the budget to fund the proposed painting of lines.

Robert intended to revise and finalize the recommendations.
