- 5. June 7, Wellness Fair on Thursday night at BMS. M. Newcomb (Health Teacher) noted skate park, YMCA, hospital, others in attendance. Timing conflicted with high school event. Consider in fall or end of April in the future.

- 11. Helmet use / availability / school. L. Kovacs. Helmets available through BPD. Recommendation to work with school to remedy at the beginning of the school year.
- 12. School / community bike repair hanger. Five repair stations (equipment / tools / stands) once weather is too bad to ride, can provide bike repair classes for kids during winter (in school). Will be looking for adults to assist. No plan for implementation with adults. Noted that Technical Education will be phased out circa 2020. May become maker space, provides potential location for bike station. Space at a premium in middle school. Discussions with Shelter Institute. Slab not build able due to proximity to road. Little slab too small. Sitting at brainstorm portion of discussion. L. Leiner noted 18x20 foot garage (one door) available from Public Works. Whether it would be a permanent structure is question for Code Enforcement. Needs underlying foundation. Not insulated. Location not known. Discussed facility in Biddeford.
- 13. Morse High School construction meetings. Bike storage discussions reviewed. Building Committee favoured hanging bikes. Not in funding currently. S. Balboni noted Mt Ararat fundraising being done to fund similar specific items.
