- 1. Welcome to our newest committee member Haley Blanco.
- 2. Discussion about entrance and exit for the new high school:
  - a. Kevin sent the recommendations for the crosswalk and the flashing beacons to the planning board
  - b. Ben will ensure that the letter is in his project file, and it has been shared with Kaily Mason, the firm project coordinator, and Ben will ensure it's part of the amendment conversation.

Discussion of need for sidewalk between entrances of Marshall Field. Agreement reached that there should be a sidewalk here and the education and advocacy committee will pursue this effort further.

Discussion of budget process and the paving bond.

- a. Current fiscal year street paving portion was 320,000 and the sidewalk portion was roughly 25,000. Committee is interested in increasing allocation towards sidewalk projects.
- b. Discussion of how bond funds are allocated and become part of the budget.
- c. Committee expressed interest in playing a more supportive role to departments in the budget process related to bike and pedestrian infrastructure projects.

  Striping Guidelines
- a. Infrastructure subcommittee has reviewed all the roads, road widths, and considered updating the road striping recommendation. Looking at the amount of traffic, confirming the road widths estimates. They will have a consolidated striping plan updated soon.
