# High Street Sidewalk (Getchell to Marshall):

- Project was put out to bid, there were two bidders, and one has been hired.
- Weather permitting, project will be completed in the next 4 to 6 weeks.

# **Budget Process (Public Works):**

- Capital request that the committee voted on was submitted to City Manager
- \$25,000 was provided. This in addition to the estimated \$50,000 already in the account will provide a total of \$75,000 for sidewalk improvements and new construction.
- The working assumption is that the Congress St project will be at the top of the list.
- This is significantly less than the committee requested and the committee is suggesting
  that additional communication between residents and Bath City Councilors should take
  place to communicate the importance of these projects.
- The Committee needs to consider additional ways to advocate and proceed with a plan for multi-year funding.
- There will be a public hearing for the City's budget on Wednesday, May 15th at 6 pm at City Hall.

#### Discussion about Street and Sidewalk Bond

- This bond covers a wide variety of infrastructure items e.g. streets repair, sidewalk repair, and in some cases storm drains and retaining walls.
- The committee would like to understand more about how spending from the bond is allocated and prioritized and will be looking for ways to encourage more funds to be allocated towards sidewalk projects.
