*The Town of Seymour is required to update the Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance in order to maintain eligibility for participation in the National Flood Insurance Program.*

*Our updated ordinance must be approved and become effective before December 17, 2010, which is the effective date of the revised Flood Insurance Rate Maps that have been given to the Town.*

*Revisions to the present Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance have been made and submitted to the State NFIP Coordinator for review. Attached is the final draft of the revised ordinance that has been approved by the State and incorporates all of the changes required for full compliance with updated State and Federal flood control standards.*

*It is recommended that the attached, revised ordinance be submitted to the Board of Selectmen for adoption prior to December 17, 2010.*

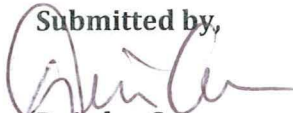
Sean Walsh, 126 Pearl Street: Would like to know if the new rate flood maps have been updated.

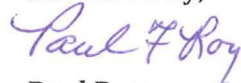
ITEM # 4 - Close Public Hearing.
