Chief's Report:

Health:

- Asst. Chief Cronin stated that physicals are progressing.

- Asst. Chief Childs attended a meeting with the project managers for the Dam project officials.
- Chief Smith would like to thank everyone for their participation in the MCI drill. He would also like a letter of thanks to be sent to Oxford, Beacon Falls, and Ansonia for their help.
