Meeting Minutes October 20, 2008 Citizens Engine Company

Commissioners Attending: Ugo Zullo, Patrick Lombardi, Scott Martin, Al Rochelle, Mike Kearney

Meeting called to order at 7:05pm, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion made to accept September meeting minutes as written by Commissioner Martin, 2nd by Commissioner Rochelle. Approved 5-0

Discussion: None

Correspondence:

- Letter from Oxford Fire Marshal Scott Pelletier stating his interest in becoming a Deputy
 Fire Marshal for the Town of Seymour. Mr. Pelletier will be called in when all
 representatives from Town are unavailable.
- Fire Marshal Wetowitz handed out a copy of the new open burn ordinance.
- Commissioner Scott Martin turned in letter stating he will not be seeking another term as Commissioner of the Seymour Fire Department. His last act as a Commissioner will be at the December 8th meeting.

Financial Report:

- Commissioner Kearney stated he has been paying invoices as they are received.
- Current budget items discussed and open P.O's reviewed.
- Commissioner Rochelle gave an update on last years P.O's that can be closed/canceled.
- Commissioner Lombardi feels there was no control over the 2007-2008 budget and he said with the next budget, vendors need to be called who haven't submitted an invoice within an appropriate time period.
- Commissioner Lombardi noted that 50% of the travel account has already been used up.
- Commissioner Lombardi stated he has set-up files in the Chief's Office for open and closed P.O's.

Fire Marshal's Report:

Fire Marshal Wetowitz read Summary of Office Activities for September 2008.

Motion made to accept Fire Marshal's Report by Commissioner Lombardi, 2nd by Commissioner Kearney. Approved 5-0

Motion made to accept Oxford Fire Marshal Scott Pelletier as Deputy Fire Marshal by Commissioner Lombardi, 2nd by Commissioner Martin. Approved 5-0

Chief's Minutes:

Motion made to accept October Meeting Minutes as written by Commissioner Martin, 2^{nd} by Commissioner Rochelle. Approved 5-0

Discussion:

- Commissioner Kearney asked Captain Wasilewski if he had received the P.O. for Derby Glass. Captain Wasilewski said yes he had it.

Old Business:

- Chief Andrews asked if there was more information regarding a debit card.
 Commissioner Lombardi said he believes this topic had been discussed previously. The Board of Finance was not in-favor of it. They suggested opening a credit account and using the tax ID number. Commissioner Lombardi said he would revisit topic with Town.
- -- Chairman Zullo asked if members could be reminded that a blue light doesn't give the authority to use excessive speed when responding to a call.

New Business:

- -- Chief Andrews received a renewal letter for Seymour Dive/Rescue Inc. from the Secretary of State. It was suggested to dissolve the incorporation. Motion made to dissolve the incorporation by Commissioner Martin, 2nd by Commissioner Lombardi. Approved 5-0
- Chief Andrews stated Firefighter John Gaudiosi had reported early this year that he had been missing equipment from his turnout gear. He said he had told company Officers, but no police report was filed. This apparently occurred in March or April and the items totaled approximately \$159.00 Chief Andrews was looking for guidance with what to do next. Chairman Zullo stated Citizens Officers should conduct their own investigation and then report information to the Chief's.
- Lt. Lewis said the gear washer is not draining and actually has flooded the area. Lt. Lewis said he told Commissioner Rochelle when it initially happened and he told Lt. Lewis it just drains slowly and it will resolve itself. Commissioner Rochelle state he doesn't remember having that conversation. He will see that it gets repaired. Lt. Lewis stated it is currently OOS.

- Chief Andrews asked about the ordinance change. Chairman Zullo said he has drafted the change and will be sending out soon.

Motion made to adjourn at 8:38pm by Commissioner Rochelle, 2nd by Commissioner Lombardi. Approved 5-0
