Chairman's Report; Judy Simpson reported that the Halloween event was a huge success. She heard from many of the merchants that they were very pleased at the crowd that showed up to take part. She estimated that at least 275 – 300 children came to Trick or Treat in costume. Thank-you letters were delivered to all the merchants that took part in this year's festivities. It was noted that next year we would plan on 300 candy bags to be handed out.

Carolers will be strolling downtown on First Saturday in December from 6:30 – 8:30 PM. Priscilla Altorelli will meet the Carolers at Town Hall and let them in to change into their costumes. They will be instructed to start at Zois and continue up Main to Bank Street. Attorney Stanek has made his porch available again for the Carolers to use to entertain the shoppers.

The Lions Club will be sent a thank-you for their participation in the Trick or Treat Day. Chairman Simpson asked Valerie D'Anna to contact all the school nurses reminding them that the Lions Club will pay for any students needing an eye exam and glasses who can not afford it.

Valerie will also apply for a matching Grant through the State for the Kerry Boys' performance next summer.

December meeting will be canceled and the next meeting will be held on January 13, 2009. Priscilla Altorelli motioned that next year's meetings be held on the second Tuesday of the month, motioned second by Valerie D'Anna
