Glen Marston gave a very informative presentation regarding grants & how to obtain them. Some sources of grant money include Land & Water Conservation Fund, U.S. Soccer Federation, National Football League, and STEAP. In order to have any success in obtaining grant money, our state senator & state representative must be on board and willing to fight for it. Grantors look favorably on matching funds. Another approach is to assess each person who uses the parks a yearly fee which would go into a dedicated account. We should contact SHS graduates who were on the football, soccer, or track teams and still have an attachment to their alma mater. The president of each graduating class has a database of graduates. Tom Hennessey, a member of the Wallingford BOE is a SHS graduate and is willing to help out. Another person to contact is Frank Cooper, a Seymour resident who is a member of the historical preservation commission. French Park is a unique, signature park which might qualify for funding. It's important to secure all permits such as P & Z and Inland Wetlands before you apply for the grants.
