The Regular Meeting of the Seymour WPCA Board for March 4th, 2013 -6pm- at the Sewer Facility.

Others present: Carey Strout, plant manager Veolia Water, Jon Marro, Atty. Ramon Sous, Jim Galligan, P.E. and other members of the public.

Chairman Jon Livolsi called meeting to order at 6:00pm

Pledge of Allegiance was given

Stephen Chucta Made a motion, Tom Kuzia 2nd, to accept the February 4th, 2013 minutes. Motion passed 3-0

First Selectman- none.

Veolia Water reports- Carey Strout reported on the huge amount of water (rain & snowmelt) that the plant had to process. The large amount of snow took a whole week to dig the plant out in addition to the pump stations. In the process of balancing the tanks — a valve for the RAS line broke; R&S Septic was employed to help dig the 19-foot hole to reach the valve itself. Discussion then ensued as to what was needed for the repair; Carey was directed towards Phoenix Machine in Seymour. Carey Strout also reported that the two RAS pumps that were approved by the board last year, have just arrived and will be installed soon. Carey mentioned that this will leave just one pump left without mechanical seals; this will improve the function and lifespan of the pumps greatly.

Income report- Jon Marro submitted this to the board.

Finance report- this was submitted to the board.

Invoices- the following (see attached) were submitted to the Board for approval.

Tom Kuzia made a motion, Stephen Chucta 2nd, to authorize Chairman Livolsi to sign the Veolia Water monthly invoice later. Motion passed 3-0.

Tom Kuzia made a motion, Stephen Chucta 2nd, to approve the invoices for payment. Motion passed 3-0.

Legal Report- Atty. Sous submitted to the board an access agreement and waiver for plant personnel to have a homeowner sign prior to entering for a sewer backup. Discussion ensued about how this waiver is to be used.

Discussion ensued about sewer use rates for sewer users in light of the new Charter revisions. Chairman Livolsi is still waiting on the Town's response to his questions and waiting for Bond council.
