Chairman Jon Livolsi called meeting to order at 6:00pm

Pledge of Allegiance was given.

Jon Livolsi and the WPCA Board directed that Jon Marro make arraignments to have delivered a fruit basked to Carey Strout as his son is in the hospital due to an accident.

Approval of December 3rd 2012 minutes- Stephen Chucta made a motion, Tom Kuzia 2nd, motion passed 3-0.

First Selectman- None

Veolia water reports- Jon Marro presented the board with the monthly report covering Plant operations, Maintenance, Collections, and Income.

Maintenance- Of note; a roller for the Belt press had to be replaced as it had fallen in its housing.

Collections- Kinneytown siphon was cleaned, a backup on 25 New Haven Ave was cleared, and a manhole near the Middle School on Mountain Road was checked; found to be flat and in good condition.

Income- Jon Marro submitted this to the board.

Financial report- this was submitted to the board.

Invoices- the following (see attached) were submitted to the board for approval.

Tom Kuzia made a motion, **Stephen Chucta 2nd**, to approve the invoices for payment. Motion passed 3-0.

OPERATIONS

The Seymour WPCF remained in compliance in each of the monitoring parameters through the month of December 2012. Average data is as follows:

Total Nitrogen in the Influent: 221 ppd

Total Nitrogen in the Effluent: 40 ppd

Percent removal: 82%

2012 Nitrogen Permit Monthly Limit is 64 Pounds per day.

Total Phosphorus in the Influent: 5.6 mg/l

Total Phosphorous in the Effluent: 3.4 mg/l

Percent removal: N/A

Ortho Phosphorous in the effluent: 2.8 mg/l

Proposed Permit Limit 0.70 mg/l

Average Flow: .66 MGD

MAINTENANCE

Plant repair and maintenance items include the following:

- Changed hoses on Influent and Effluent samplers
- Changed belt on belt press
- Fixed a roller on belt press

COLLECTION SYSTEM

- Checked all pump stations
- Cleaned Kinneytown Siphon with flush truck
- Cleared a backup on 25 New Haven Avenue- plug was found on Spruce St.
- Checked manhole on Mountain Ave at the Middle School- found to be flat and in good condition.
- Did several mark-outs for Call Before you Dig.
