# The Regular Meeting of the Seymour WPCA Board for October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012 -6pm- at the Sewer Facility.

Members attending; Jon Livolsi, Stephen Chucta and Tom Kuzia

Members not present: Annmarie Drugonis

**Others present**: Carey Strout, Veolia water plant manager, Jon Marro, Jim Galligan, Atty. Ramon Sous and other members of the public.

Jon Livolsi called meeting to order at 6:00pm

Pledge of Allegiance was given.

On Atty. Sous recommendation, **Tom Kuzia** made a motion, Stephen Chucta 2<sup>nd</sup>, to add executive session on Konnick vs. CTDOT and Seymour WPCA before public comment. Motion passed 3-0.

**Stephen Chucta** made a motion, Tom Kuzia 2<sup>nd</sup>, to accept the September 10<sup>th</sup>, 2012 minutes. Motion passed 3-0.

First Selectman- no report.

**39 Colony Road**- Sebastian Zawadski homeowner. Mr. Zawadski presented to the board that when he bought the house in 2006, he was told that the house was connected to the sewer. Mr. Zawadski contacted the WPCA to inform them of his connection. The WPCA board discussed the sewer connection fee and impact fee that the original owner/builder should have paid this at the time that the house was built (1996). However, the impact and connection fee is on the property; the fee must be paid, in addition to the 3 years of sewer use bills, interest and the dye testing fee. **Tom Kuzia** made a motion, Stephen Chucta 2<sup>nd</sup>, for a bill to be given to the homeowner of 39 Colony Road, which includes 3 years of sewer use, interest, dye test fee, connection and impact fees. Motion passed 3-0. Jon Livolsi the asked the homeowner to keep in touch with Atty. Sous.

**Tom Kuzia** made a motion, Stephen Chucta 2<sup>nd</sup>, to move engineering report to #6 in front of Veolia water reports. Motion passed 3-0.

**Engineering report**- Jim Galligan reported that Tim Sadick (R&S Septic) will be starting on Wednesday, October 3<sup>rd</sup> to work on the Kalarides Siphon; if the weather cooperates this repair should be finished by Friday.

Stormwater permit- Jim Galligan reported that this is resolved; this was a town issue not a WPCA issue.

Jim Galligan reported that he will be in touch with Brennan Construction about the directional drilling on the sewer pipe on Rennay Road.

Manners Avenue- Discussion ensued about the offer of payment for the non-contracted extras on this project. Ray Sous will prepare a release and Jim Galligan will approach the contractor with the offer (if it is acceptable). This will be discussed at next meeting also.

### Veolia Water reports-

Carey Strout reported that September was a great month for nitrogen removal. Also #1 RAS pump was realigned, and the thickeners (rotary drum)- having the bearings repaired.

Income report- Jon Marro submitted this to the board

Financial report- this was submitted to the board.

Invoices- the following (see attached) were submitted to the board for approval.

**Tom Kuzia** made a motion, Stephen Chucta 2<sup>nd</sup>, to authorize payment for the invoices. Motion passed 3-0.

Executive session- Konnik v. CTDOT v. Seymour WPCA.

At 6:24pm, **Stephen Chucta** made a motion, Tom Kuzia 2<sup>nd</sup>, to enter into executive session. Motion passed 3-0.

At 6:30pm the board emerged from executive session, no motions were made and no votes were taken; **Stephen Chucta** made a motion, Tom Kuzia 2<sup>nd</sup> to this effect. Motion passed 3-0.

### **Public Comment:**

Jon Livolsi stated "I want to thank John Fanotto for 14 plus years he worked here, as a WPCA Chairman, and gave his expertise and engineering advice to the board and everyone else who came in. He will be sorely missed." Carey Strout asked the board if they wanted a letter thanking John Fanotto for his hard work. WPCA board gave its assent.

**Stephen Chucta** made a motion, Tom Kuzia 2<sup>nd</sup>, to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed 3-0. Meeting ended at 6:35pm.

The Seymour WPCF was in compliance in all of the monitoring parameters through the month of September, 2012. Here is some relevant data.
