Special Meeting of the Seymour WPCA – October 19th 2010-6pm- At the Sewer Facility.

Members Present: John Fanotto, Stephen Chucta, Jon Livolsi and Lou DeBarber

Members not Present: Alex Danka

Others Present: Carey Strout, Veolia water Plant Manager, Jon Marro, Jim Galligan, P.E., and other members of the public.

John Fanotto called meeting to order at 6:05pm

Pledge of Allegiance was given.

Stephen Chucta made the motion, Jon Livolsi 2nd, to approve the Sept 7th 2010 minutes. Motion passed 3-0-1 (Lou DeBarber abstained).

Veolia Water Reports-

Carey Strout reported that there is problem with the thickener discharge pump in basement- he will be getting quotes for that. Also, the bellows for the air system for the belt press needs to be replaced (Carey received a quote from Andritz for \$1556). After looking at the specs from Andritz, **Jon Livolsi** made a motion, Lou DeBarber 2nd, approved the purchase. Motion passed 4-0. Carey Strout reported on several repairs on belt press and pump stations.

<u>34 Pershing Avenue</u>- at the request at the homeowner, her house was dye-tested and was found not to be connected to sewer main but rather to an old private line on George Street. Discussion ensued about the homeowner's situation and that there are other houses connected to private sewer lines.

Jon Livolsi made a motion, Stephen Chucta 2nd, for 34 Pershing Avenue to refund 3 years of sewer use (496.00) and to waive sewer connection fees. Motion passed 4-0.

<u>Oxford H.S.</u> – Carey Strout gave John Fanotto a discharge permit to sign. School officials did not know that the Oxford H.S. needed a discharge permit for their pool. Jon Livolsi made a motion, Stephen Chucta 2nd, to accept and sign the discharge permit for the Oxford H.S. Motion passed 4-0.

Carey Strout reported that the Chevy 1987 white van was donated to Habitat for Humanity.

Income Report- Jon Marro submitted this to the board.

Invoices - the following invoices (see attached) were submitted to the board for approval of payment.

Discussion ensued about the late payment of various invoices, and the board directed that Jon Marro & Carey Strout check into whether or not the submitted invoices are getting paid on time.

Discussion also ensued about the misinformation about the WPCA response to the sewer backup that occurred on 27 French Street. Carey Strout informed the board that the sewer crew travelled and relieved the blockage in about 45 minutes. This occurred while the board approved an invoice from Servpro for that address.

Also, Jon Marro was directed to get a total of the invoices submitted by Seymour PD.

Jon Livolsi made a motion, Stephen Chucta 2nd, to approve the invoices for payment. Motion passed 4-0.

Engineering Report-

Jim Galligan was directed to call Bill Brennan as regards Rennay Road.

Easement Clearing- Jim Galligan was asked what sewer easements Jim Weed had cleared, Jim Galligan responded that he is meeting Jim Weed on the next day to discuss this. John Fanotto wanted a call from Jim Galligan to go over what progress is being made.

Manners Avenue- The contractor working on this found asbestos pipe in concrete, and is laying a pipe alongside of the current pipe. Discussion ensued about the coverage necessary for engineering projects when Jim Galligan is on vacation.

There was a sewer backup on Route 67 (near Sweets & Eats) that was caused by root infiltration, and John Fanotto wanted Carey Strout to inform the First Selectman of the importance of easement clearing, as concerns this backup in particular. Carey Strout is going to have the UGAM team televise the sewer line, and will have Dukes spray root suppressant in the sewer line.

Brook Street- John Fanotto directed Jim Galligan to have a design ready.

Legal Report- Atty. Kulas was not present.

Finance Report- This was submitted to the board. Discussion ensued about the various concerns of the board members about how the maintenance is eating into the available funds, and the lack of income from various building projects is impacting the available funds. Discussion also ensued about how the

board could investigate about possible bonding for the various sewer repairs around town and how there might be a sewer rate increase for next year.

Discussion then ensued vacancies will be addressed.

Public Comment- None.

Stephen Chucta made the motion, Jon Livolsi 2nd, to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed 4-0. Meeting ended at 6:52pm.

The Seymour WPCF remained in compliance in each of the monitoring parameters through the month of September, 2010. Average data is as follows: BOD-97% Removal (Effluent average= 6 MG/L) TSS-100% removal (Effluent average= 0 MG/L) Flow 0.64 MGD
