**The Regular Meeting of the Seymour WPCA Board for March
3rd, 2014 -6pm- at the Sewer Facility.**

Members attending: Jon Livolsi, Stephen Chucta, Annmarie Drugonis and Patrick Lombardi.

Members not present: Tom Kuzia

Others present: Carey Strout, plant manager Veolia Water, Jon Marro, Atty. Ramon Sous and other members of the public.

Chairman Jon Livolsi called meeting to order at 6:00pm

Pledge of Allegiance was given.

Stephen Chucta made a motion, Jon Livolsi 2nd, to accept the February 10th 2014 minutes. Motion passed 3-0-1 (Annmarie Drugonis abstained).

First Selectman- none

Veolia Water reports-

Carey Strout reported on plant performance, and maintenance- SAS performed annual inspection of fire alarm system, and the west side sludge mixer was removed and was brought up for welding. Carey Strout also reported on the replacement of a Sewer manhole frame on Franklin Street. The sewer inspection of the lines in Kalarides Plaza was done- no blockage found. Ansonia WPCA was contacted about the Friars Lane sewers owing sewer use arrears, a copy of the intermunicipal agreement with Ansonia has not been found at the plant. Carey Strout reported on 37-39 Skokorat Street- sewer crew responded to check the main line, and soon after this 31 Skokorat reported problems with their line. Sewer crews went out, checked and ran the sewer lines all the way to French Street. After some discussion about this sewer line, Carey Strout was directed to inspect Chatfield School's grease trap.

Income report- Jon Marro submitted this to the board.

Financial report- this was submitted to the board.

Invoices- the following (see attached) were submitted to the board for authorization.

Discussion ensued about the invoices.

Annmarie Drugonis made a motion, **Stephen Chucta 2nd**, to accept the invoices for payment. Motion passed 4-0.

Legal report- Atty. Sous reported that other than the ongoing collections, that some one from the board might want to attend the Ordinance committee meeting (which was postponed due to weather) to inform a counter point to having a depreciation expense on the WPCA budget. Discussion ensued about this issue.

Adjournment- **Annmarie Drugonis** made a motion, **Stephen Chucta 2nd**, to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed 4-0. Meeting ended at 6:55pm.

OPERATIONS

The Seymour WPCF was in compliance in all of the monitoring parameters through the month of February, 2014. Here is some relevant data.

Total Nitrogen in the influent: 233 pounds per day
Total Nitrogen in the effluent: 23 pounds per day
Percent Removal 98%
2013 Nitrogen Permit Monthly Limit is 62 pounds per day

Total Phosphorous in the influent: 4.6 mg/l
Total Phosphorous in the effluent 1.3 mg/l
Percent Removal 68%
Ortho Phosphorous in the effluent: 1.22 mg/l
Proposed Permit limit 0.70 mg/l

Average Flow 1.16 MGD
