Minutes of the Seymour WPCA- Special Agenda- February 5th, 2015

Board Members Present; Jon Livolsi, Tom Kuzia, and Stephen Chucta

Board Members Not Present: Patrick Lombardi and Annmarie Drugonis.

Others Present; Carey Strout, Veolia Water Plant Manager, Jon Marro, Atty. Ramon Sous, Jim Galligan, P.E., and other members of the public.

Jon Livolsi called the meeting to order at 6pm.

Pledge of Allegiance was given.

Approval of January 2015 Minutes- Tom Kuzia made a motion, Stephen Chucta 2nd, to accept the minutes. Motion passed 3-0.

First Selectman- None.

"Phyllis Ann Acres"-Jacko Drive- Don Smith, P.E., representing owner Stanley Jachimowski-

Don Smith reported this project entails the extension of the sewer 150', and creating 3 new building lots. Also lot 25 (previously lot 23) which has an assessment (never paid) placed on this land (\$6,934.00). Jim Galligan reported that lots 1-3 need to be assessed as the sewer bond has not been retired, and the lot 25 (previously lot 23) needs to be paid and the designed drawings are acceptable. The extension is to be an 8-inch line. Don Smith then requested that the assessment amount be reduced by the board. Atty. Sous then reported that on a non-retired bond the lots have to be charged full amount of assessment each. Discussion ensued about the law, and what has been past practice of the board.

Tom Kuzia made a motion, Stephen Chucta 2nd, that lots 1,2,3 and existing lot 25 (previously 23) are to be assessed \$6,934.00 each plus inspection fee of \$3,213.00, the subdivision is accepted. Motion passed 3-0.

Veolia Water Reports-

Carey Strout reported that the plant operated within permit parameters.

Not much to report on Maintenance- Removed a lot of snow—and replaced 4 capacitors at Titus pump station. Sewer call-out on Colony Rd- a manhole that was reported as backed up, was in fact, for storm

drains. There was a back-up on the corner of Cedar and Rose Street-the sewer manhole was backed up-the sewer line was jetted but the operators reported that a part of the sewer line is broken (clay pipe).

Discussion ensued about 2 letters submitted to the board that complain about having to pay interest and lien release fees that are still owed. Atty. Sous was made fully aware of these persons and will make clear to them that no interest or fees will be waived per state statute.

Carey Strout- presented the board with a quote from Northeast Balance Service to replace the (20 years old) lab scale for \$1,421.25 versus repairing for \$800+. **Tom Kuzia** made a motion, Stephen Chucta 2nd, to accept the quote for \$1,421.25 to replace the scale. Motion passed 3-0.

Income Report- Jon Marro submitted this to the board.

Financial report- this was submitted to the board.

Invoices- the following (see attached) invoices were presented to the board for authorization.

Tom Kuzia made a motion, Stephen Chucta 2nd, to accept the invoices for payment. Motion passed 3-0.

Legal Report- Atty. Ramon Sous- reported on the Friar Lane situation. He contacted the Mayor Cassetti of Ansonia, who visited the street and reported on 5 not 3 houses on Friar's Lane. Ansonia WPCA, via Rita St. Jacques, claimed (without any list of houses) that there are properties that are in Seymour but are connected to Ansonia. Discussion ensued about the Friar's Lane situation.

Engineering Report- Jim Galligan reported that he explained to Stanley Jachimowski that there is a process to rescind the motion, on his subdivision. If he (the owner) does not have the motion rescinded at the next WPCA meeting the decision is final.

Tom Kuzia made a motion, Stephen Chucta 2nd, to move the meeting to a special meeting on March 9th 2015 (Monday). Motion passed 3-0.

Public Comment-None

Stephen Chucta made a motion, Tom Kuzia 2nd, to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed. Meeting ended 6:44pm.

The Seymour WPCF was in compliance in all of the monitoring parameters through the month of January, 2014. Here is some relevant data.

Total Nitrogen in the influent: 285 pounds per day
Total Nitrogen in the effluent: 58 pounds per day
Percent Removal 80%
2013 Nitrogen Permit Monthly Limit is 61 pounds per day

Total Phosphorous in the influent: 4.33 mg/l
Total Phosphorous in the effluent 2.66 mg/l
Percent Removal 61%
Ortho Phosphorous in the effluent: 2.55 mg/l
Proposed Permit limit 0.70 mg/l

Average Flow 1.10 MGD
