Minutes of the Seymour WPCA- Special Meeting- March 9th, 2015

Board Members Present; Jon Livolsi, Annmarie Drugonis, Patrick Lombardi, and Stephen Chucta

Board Members Not Present: Tom Kuzia.

Others Present; Carey Strout, Veolia Water Plant Manager, Jon Marro, Atty. Ramon Sous, Jim Galligan, P.E., and other members of the public.

Jon Livolsi called the meeting to order at 6pm.

Pledge of Allegiance was given.

Approval of February 9th 2015 minutes- Stephen Chucta made a motion, Jon Livolsi 2nd, to accept the minutes. Motion passed 2-0-2 (Annmarie Drugonis and Patrick Lombardi were not present for last meeting).

First Selectman- None.

Phyllis Ann Acres- Jacko Drive- Don Smith, P.E. representing- Don Smith presented the subdivision, and was looking for a motion to rescind the motion from last month setting the assessment price on the 3 lots in question. **Annmarie Drugonis** made a motion, Patrick Lombardi 2nd, to rescind the motion from the February 9th, 2015 meeting with regard to the Jacko Drive subdivision. Motion passed 4-0. Then a new motion was made by **Annmarie Drugonis**, Patrick Lombardi 2nd, to approve the application by Stanley Jachimowski for Jacko Drive; the existing lot remains at the assessment of \$6,934.00, lots #1 and #2 to be assessed at \$6,934.00 per lot to be paid at the time of building permit, lot #3 is at \$3,500 (plus a connection fee of \$450) and because future extension is proposed as part of the application, a \$450 connection fee (at minimum) would be assessed. {Mylar Asbuilts to be made and given to plant}. Motion passed 4-0.

Annmarie Drugonis made a motion, Patrick Lombardi, to move invoices ahead of Veolia Water reports. Motion passed 4-0.

Invoices-

Annmarie Drugonis made a motion, Patrick Lombardi 2nd, to approve the following invoices (see attached) for payment. Motion passed 4-0.

Annamarie Drugonis then left at 6:08pm.

Veolia Water Reports- Carey Strout presented to the board a CL&P electrical survey- the current light bulbs (T-12) are getting phased out, 100 lights are either out or dim and at \$40+ each to replace, CL&P will take out ballasts and put in newer T-8 bulbs for the entire plant for \$13,616 and will rebate \$4195. Jon Livolsi wants a switch for the front lights of the main building. **Patrick Lombardi** made a motion, Stephen Chucta 2nd, to accept the quote and get the front lights on a switch. Motion passed 3-0.

RAS sludge pump is broken, and rebuild is \$6450—brand new would be \$18,000. Stephen Chucta made a motion, Patrick Lombardi 2nd, to accept the quote for \$6,450 to rebuild. Motion passed 3-0.

Carey Strout reported on the status of the plant, and was in compliance for the month.

EPA inquiry- 503 report- Carey Strout is working on the response.

Bahr Sales- Camera is still not working, trying to get an ETA for repair time.

Discussion ensued about INI because of rainfall and spring melt of frozen ground.

Collections systems- Responded to a sewer backup- Canfield near ROW- Sewer crew flushed the main line, but two manholes are covered by many feet of snow. The homeowner has a 100+ foot long lateral, and the plumbing service prior to this did not even use the two cleanouts of the lateral (which runs through a patch of woods-possible root infiltration). When the snow has melted, the sewer crews will go out and check the manholes.

Nickelmine pump station- new battery charger installed.

Discussion then ensued as to the “problem areas” of the sewer lines- and the maintaining of them.

Income Report- Jon Marro submitted this to the board

Finance Report- this was submitted to the board.

Legal report- Atty. Sous reported on the Friar’s Drive- The Ansonia WPCA wants to meet with the board members—when particulars of what properties in Seymour connected to Ansonia sewer- no details were supplied by the Ansonia WPCA admin at all. After some discussion, Jon Livolsi directed Atty. Sous (with Jim Galligan) to meet with Ansonia WPCA at their board meeting.

Engineering Report- None

Public Comment- None

Adjournment- Patrick Lombardi made a motion, Stephen Chucta 2nd, to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed 3-0. Meeting ended at 6:27pm.
