### Minutes of the Seymour WPCA- Regular Meeting- September 14<sup>th</sup>, 2015- At the Sewer Plant, 6pm.

**Board Members Present:** Jon Livolsi, Annmarie Drugonis, Stephen Chucta and Patrick Lombardi.

**Others Present:** Carey Strout, Veolia Water Plant Manager, Jim Galligan, P.E., Atty. Ramon Sous and other members of the public.

Jon Livolsi called the meeting to order at 6:00pm

**Pledge of Allegiance** was given.

**Annmarie Drugonis** made a motion, Patrick Lombardi 2<sup>nd</sup>, to accept the August 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2015 minutes. Motion passed 4-0.

**First Selectman-** None.

**Veolia Water Reports-** Carey Strout reported that the plant was in compliance within its monthly permit levels.

Carey Strout reported on Maintenance items; the new sampler is installed, the new mixer #3 is installed and a light was installed for the parking lot. In addition, the conveyor had both rolls replaced and all three anoxic mixers had their heaters replaced.

**Income Report-** this was submitted to the board

**Financial report-** this was submitted to the board.

**Invoices-** the following (see attached) were submitted to the board for approval of payment.

**Pat Lombardi** made a motion, Stephen Chucta 2<sup>nd</sup> to accept the invoices for payment. Motion passed 4-0.

**Legal Report-** Atty. Ramon Sous reported on his collections efforts and the setup of payment plans.

Tax sale on Sept 9<sup>th</sup> 2015, by the tax collector, sold Prospect Avenue and the WPCA did not get paid the past due balance. Atty. Sous explained how the tax collector doesn't have to include the WPCA.

Discussion ensued about how to collect what is owed to WPCA. Atty. Sous wants to approach the Marshall to ensure that any past due money owed to the WPCA is paid, from these Tax Sales.

**Annmarie Drugonis** made a motion, **Patrick Lombardi 2<sup>nd</sup>**, to give the Attorney the right to employee the Marshall to retrieve the WPCA money from all three properties that are up for Tax Sale. Motion passed 4-0.

Atty. Sous reported that there is a Request for Proposal to operate the Sewer Plant that is being reviewed by him and the Town's Attorney.

**Engineering Report-** Jim Galligan also reported on the RFP. He will be getting prices from the two vendors who submitted to the RFQ, by the 30<sup>th</sup> of September. It will be in time for the October 5<sup>th</sup>, 2015 WPCA meeting.

For the PAC removal – Jim Galligan stated that a meeting to design the system on this upcoming Wednesday.

Jim Galligan discussed the ongoing paving project and how they are replacing the sewer manhole rings and frames if cracked.

**Public Comment:** None

**Adjournment-** Annmarie Drugonis made a motion, Pat Lombardi 2<sup>nd</sup>, to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed 4-0. Meeting ended at 6:30pm.
