

Chief's attending: Michael Lombardi, Thomas Tomasheski, and Doug Zaniewski.

Meeting called to order at 7:30 pm, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. April Minutes:

Motion made to accept April Minutes made by Asst. Chief Tomasheski, 2nd by Asst. Chief Zaniewski. Approved 3-0.

4. Correspondence: None

5. Unfinished Business-

A. Asst. Chief Tomasheski asked about department patches. Asst. Chief Lombardi stated there was a hold up because of email going to a spam folder and the production started as of about a week and half ago.

B. Asst. Chief Zaniewski stated that all information has been entered for Great Hill on Salamander system and he will work with Citizens next.

6. Driver Training-

Capt. Edwards stated Great Hill got 5 juniors and 8 new members from the recruitment drive.
