June 24, 2015

Young Men's Basketball Night concluded on June 17th. Hoping to run it again in the fall

Playgrounds scheduled to open on June 29, 2015. As of 6/23 we have 171 registered for Chatfield Park & 181 registered for Gary Park.

We had to go to our alternate list to hire counselors as some declined their offer for a position due to a better opportunity elsewhere and our numbers are up a bit.

Secured Bounce Houses for both parks on August 4th as a new activity for the playground program participants.

Community Wide Bus Trip to a Mets game is planned on Sunday August 16th vs. the Pirates. \$55.00 per person which includes ticket, round trip bus transportation and a Mike Piazza shirt. Bus Leaves Community Center at 9:15 AM. Game at 1:00 PM. We have 54 tickets and already 22 were sold.

Tickets available for the Bus Trip to Radio City Music Hall in New York City to see the "Christmas Show" for Saturday, November 21st. \$93.00 per person includes round trip transportation, orchestra level seat for the 11:00 AM show and some time on your own in NYC.

Two swim instructors and three lifeguards are secured for the summer swim program at the high school.

The playground staff had their training night and certification courses completed on June 16, 2015. All passed and are ready to work.
