# Item #1 - Call Meeting to order

Chairman Bill Sawicki called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

## Item #3 - Deliberation and Discussion of 2015/2016 Budget

The Board of Finance discussed the following department's budget:

- Assessor's Office only major increase was in the contract services and this was an additional \$2,000 for the map updates; last update was in 2006; update includes color photography provided by the Valley Council of Governments and addition of new roads.
- ❖ <u>Culture & Arts Commission</u> no increase; many thanks for what is there.
- Tax Collector had zero increase; First Selectman cut \$2,500; property tax refunds have been moved to the Contingency line item.
- \* <u>Economic Development Department</u> Other Professional Services \$20,000 this money is for things like engineering or environmental services should the town have need of them for the Greenway Project or others; also could be used for demolition of blighted properties. Regarding the Greenway Project we received grant money from the state the project will cost about \$700,000. We received \$250,000 towards construction, but the town will need to provide the designs and a portion of the construction money. The contract for this is in the process of being signed. Regarding the Tri Town Plaza long term lease is in place; has been listed with a realtor. We have the sale of LoPresti School almost complete; is with the lawyers and assessors right now finalizing (42 apartments will be built there).
- <u>Economic Development Commission</u> The \$9,000 line item is for: \$7,500 Critical Signage (parking area signs) 10 signs. The other \$1,500 is for the website and Map of Downtown. Lot of volunteer work done by committee members.
