Item #3 - Deliberation and Discussion of 2016/2017 Budget

The Board of Finance discussed and deliberated on various departmental requests for the current budget

- Board of Education: set at \$32,599,415
- Expenses: no discussion
- Revenues:
 - O New line item for "Municipal Revenue Sharing Sales Tax" for \$494,298 was for the ½ -cent sales tax collected and earmarked for municipal aid.
 - New line item for "Motor Vehicle Property Grants" for \$249,143 was for the reimbursement for loss of revenue due to the new state mandate on the mill rate for motor vehicles. We have a projected loss in revenue of \$268,500.
 - Need to remove line item for "Oxford Payment" as this is complete
 - Contingency is at \$205,000; Use of Fund Balance is at \$80,000
 - Mill rate would be increased by 1.41 mills; the revaluation will cause taxes to be less.
- Motion to:
 - Set the expenses and revenues for the 2016/2017 budget for the Town of Seymour at \$56,152,740
 - o Set the general mill rate at 36.0 (the mill rate for motor vehicles is at 32.0 per state mandate)
