The public hearing was opened at 6:30 p.m.

M. Horbal stated that he had some concerns with the fees in the new regulations and also the requirement for certified mailings. He also felt that State and federal government projects should be listed in the regulations. He stated that he was mostly concerned with the increased fees.

Robert Rich, 9 North Benham Road stated that he is also concerned with the fees and he felt that they would be stifling business. He stated that an applicant has to get a driveway bond when a building permit is taken out. He felt that a bond to cover any extraordinary issues could be required or if a developer does something wrong or disregards the wetlands.

Jaime Brennan, 124 Bungay Road stated that he did not see any list of penalties and felt that they should be included. He also felt that abutting property owners should be allowed to speak at a meeting.
