Further the Board directs the Administration to offer an alternative educational opportunity to the student for the period of this expulsion, pursuant to Connecticut general Statutes Section 10-233d(d) as determined by the duly convened PPT.

The Board further directs the administration, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 10-233d(f) to record this expulsion on the student's cumulative educational record, to be expunged from such record if the student graduates from high school.

Finally, the Board authorizes the Board chair, Jennifer Magri, and Attorney Fred Dorsey to communicate in writing to the student and/or his/her parents, as appropriate, the Board's decision and the reasons therefore, consistent with the Board's executive session discussion.
