Item #1 - Call Meeting to order

Vice Chairman Annmarie Drugonis called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Everyone saluted the Flag and recited the Pledge of Allegiance. Annmarie Drugonis asked for a moment of silence in memory of Bruce Baker (previous selectman).

Item #3 - Public Comment

<u>Nancy Martin – 38 Columbus Street</u> – commented regarding the recent paving & striping done along Bank & Columbus Street. There are NO handicapped spaces along Columbus Street or Bank Street. Previously there were two handicapped spaces (ISA). Upon inquiring at the First Selectman's Office, Ms. Martin was told that the Engineering Department told them that "higher ups" had told them that under no circumstances were handicapped spots to be put on these streets. This has caused Ms. Martin and others great hardship in finding parking close to her home. The difficulties are even worse in the snow. During the most recent snow storm, the business owners did not properly clear off their sidewalks and the Public Works Department did not clear the walkways from the parking lots downtown. There is no need for the fire lane to be the entire length of the streets. There should be handicapped parking spots downtown. Ms. Martin would like to know why there are none and whom she can contact to facilitate putting handicapped spots in place.

Item #10 – Discussion & Take Possible Action Regarding Constellation Energy/Power Options Agreement for Purchase of Electricity

Presented by Rory Burke. The Town previously had a multi-year contract with Constellation Energy/Power Options for electricity which expired in October. Initially, Town Counsel had identified some potential conflicts with some of the agreements (with Johnson Controls & ECG Engineering). But these have been worked out and this agreement has been signed and approved by Johnson Controls, ECG Engineering, Tony Caserta (Town Operations Manager) and Rick Belden (Board of Education). A 48-month term has been selected as our best option to minimize costs.

- Trisha Danka asked if there were any differences in this contract from the previous one. Rory Burke said that the contracts were essentially the same, except the prices which are higher.
- Bob Findley asked if the price change was comparable from 12 to 48 months? Rory Burke said yes.
- Trisha Danka said that there were several options listed in the agreement. Which options are we taking and which are we not? Can we change our decision on these options at a later date within the contract term? Rory Burke did not think so.
- Stephan Behuniak asked what happens if we don't approve this tonight. Rory Burke said that we would
 continue on a month-to-month basis (pricing is MUCH higher and more volatile). Rick Belden and Tony
 Caserta thought that the 4 year option was the best.
- Stephan Behuniak asked how we cam to enter into this consortium. Rory Burke said that we had just ended a contract with them (expired in October).
- Brian LeClair and Rory Burke said that there is a 5,000 megawatt threshold that we need to meet. If we go below, there would be certain penalties. The Board of Education and the Town are close to this threshold, but Johnson Controls, ECG Engineering, Tony Caserta and Rick Belden all felt that we should agree to this contract.
