David Bitso/Lucy McConologue motion to have the Deputy Chief post for the replacement for the second in command and this position will require a Bachelor Degree and three years of supervisor position qualifications. **Motion: 5:0**


Chairman Koskelowski states that the Board is using basically the same criteria as what the one that is leaving that position presently had when he got that position.
