**Item #5: Ongoing projects**

The LED streetlight conversion is now complete. Some lights were not converted to LED due to special considerations such as specialized fixtures required, or difficulties with accessing the lights. Any lights that were believed to be missed can be reported to town hall.

Johnson Controls has entered into an agreement with the town for an energy savings performance contract. This contract guarantees a constant energy cost for 18 years and energy efficiency upgrades to the town's buildings. The ECG Group is the engineering firm for the project and acts as a third party to ensure the efficiency projects are the best deal for the town. Early analysis shows solar on school to be the biggest energy saver.

The Town of Seymour is now officially signed up for Sustainable CT. The committee has reviewed the Sustainable CT checklist and has identified items that can be completed with a town wide flyer on sustainable practices and items that can be completed by the town's planners and other town boards and committees.

Details on how to allocate the Bright Ideas CT grant were delayed to the next Sustainability Committee meeting when more members are present.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting.


