First Selectman, W. Kurt Miller, led the salute to the flag. He then turned the meeting over to Town Clerk, Lianna McMurray.

The Annual Town Meeting of the Electors and Citizens qualified to vote in the Town meetings of the Town of Seymour, Connecticut, will be held at Middle School, Seymour, CT, Thursday, April 25, 2019 @ 6:00PM.

1. To consider the 2019/2020 Budget as recommended by the Board of Finance. Town incomes are \$ 57,375,610 and expenses are \$ 57,375,610 (Board of Education \$34,158,039 and Town \$23,217,571). This meeting will be adjourned until May 9, 2019 thereupon the town voters will act on the Budgets. This action will occur by machine vote at the Community Center, 20 Pine Street, from 6:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.
