7) Unfinished Business:



b) Discussion was had regarding the Fire Police position.

8) New Business:

 a) Meadowbrook Estates Hydrants- Discussion was had regarding the hydrants at Meadowbrook Estates. Oxford took over the 25 on their side, there are 3 on the Seymour side. No records on if they hydrants have ever been serviced. The only





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concern is if Balance Rock and April Gardens get wind of this and want SFD to take over their hydrants as well.

Al Rochelle/Chris Edwards made a motion to forward to the commissioners that SFD take over the three hydrants. Vote: 4/0

- b) Shoreline Airline- Discussion was had regarding having airlines dropped down to trucks. Next year to be done at Great Hill. Chris Edwards/Dave Van Wart made a motion to recommend Citizens Engine get set up with shoreline air. Vote: 4/0
- c) Misc. Fire Police Equipment- Fire police are requesting reflective gloves for the winter.
- d) Pumpkin Fest- Citizens Engine will be covering.
- e) Physical updates- Update given on status of physicals

9) Training: Update was given on the status of members attending FF1 and FF2

A lot of issues with air packs over the past few months. Eventually the manufacturer will stop making part for the air packs. It was suggested to buy the parts in bulk now before that happens.

Batteries will be ordered every six months.
