

RECREATION COMMISSION SPECIAL MEETING

Wednesday, June 5, 2019 – 6:00 PM

The “special” meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM.

Item #3 - Public Comment:

Item #4 – Correspondence:

Item #5 – Approval of minutes for 3/27/2019:

There has been 19, head, camp counselors hired to work the summer camp, and one more may need to be added if the number of attendees reach 300. There will be 5 counselors in training, aged 14-15yrs old. Some of the new activities of the summer camp were talked about, such as, the Summer cook out on July 1st, a silly string challenge, the Circle K petting zoo, and an Illusionist. Z. Phillippas also stated that all other programs are doing very well.
