The Ocean City Police would like to remind everyone that possession and/or use of fireworks is prohibited in the City by New Jersey State Statute: Title 21:3-2. All violations of this statute require that you appear in Municipal Court. The Police Department will be in full operation over the Fourth of July weekend recalling all of duty personnel. There will be a zero tolerance policy when enforcing the fireworks laws. Officers will be paying special attention to enforcement of Driving While Intoxicated offenders, pedestrian safety, illegal alcohol consumption and parking regulations throughout the city.

Officers will be patrolling the known problem areas on foot and by vehicle to enforce these regulations. We want everyone to have a safe and enjoyable holiday weekend by obeving the laws of the State. By violating the above laws you not only risk your own safety but that of innocent people that are here to enjoy all that Ocean City has to offer. This will be your only warning given by the police.
