INCIDENT: Parking Meter Ordinance Changes

DATE/TIME OCCURRED: Effective Immediately

LOCATION: Downtown Shopping District

DETAILS:

Ordinance 12-07 was adopted by City Council on May 10, 2012. This ordinance created a variety of changes to downtown parking. These changes are:

- 1) The ordinance extends the effective enforcement period of the meters from the existing 9am-6pm to 9am-9pm.
- 2) The extension of the current 2 hour parking limit to 3 hours.
- 3) Allows the meters to accept dimes and nickels, as well as quarters
- 4) Allows for additional meters to be placed on the east side of the 1300 block of Asbury

As a reminder, downtown parking relative to the above is considered to be between 6th and 14th Streets on Asbury, and certain side streets between West and Central Avenues. **ALL SIGNS ARE NOW POSTED.**
