OLD BUSINESS/NEW BUSINESS

Thornbury Twp. Sewer Treatment Plant

Mr. MacEwen reported that Pennoni submits a yearly Chapter 94 Report to DEP. It is a summary of the Thornbury Twp. Sewer Treatment Plant's, capacity, past flows, and 3-year projection. The most recent Report will be mailed to the

members for their review in advance of the next meeting. It is possible that the flow is well under the design capacity, except for the 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. peak flows. Mr. MacEwen reported to the Board in July that residents near the plant expressed concern over the plant's odor. The odor control pump will be back in service soon and the Township is considering a spare rebuilt pump.

Mr. Morley attended a recent Concord Twp. Sewer Auth. Meeting in which changes were made. Thornbury Township's Board will act on it at their Aug. 6 meeting. Mr. MacEwen thought Pennoni investigated hybrid and gravity systems. Mr. Jacquet preferred a gravity system with the lines going in the road rather than alongside the road.

Locksley Road Sewer Service

Mr. MacEwen noted that a letter was received last month in which the owner of 137 Locksley Rd. requested to utilize the existing inactive force main in Locksley Rd., but he did not show up tonight.

Township Manager's Report

The Manager's 7/24/08 was highlighted and briefly discussed.
