

## **Ocean View Police Department Monthly Report** **For the March 2015 Town Council Meeting**

➤ **CJIS Criminal Record Validations**

Staff completed monthly validations on wanted person and stolen article files per CJIS guidelines.

➤ **State Police Chief's Meeting**

Chief McLaughlin attended the monthly state police chief's meeting on Tuesday, February 10th, 2015.

➤ **School Bike Rodeo Meeting**

Chief McLaughlin met with members of the Millville Volunteer Fire Company and DeIDOT officials on Thursday, February 12<sup>th</sup> to discuss plans for a police/fire company sponsored bike safety rodeo event planned for the spring of 2015.

➤ **Delaware Overdose Survival Education Program**

On February 12<sup>th</sup> the Ocean View Police Department sponsored a heroin overdose prevention/education workshop.

➤ **Officer For a Day Program**

Invitations have been sent out for the Officer for a Day program scheduled for March 23rd. This is an 8-hour program designed to provide the participants with a unique opportunity to experience street policing from the Officer's perspective.

➤ **Speed Trailer Deployment**

The police department's speed trailer was deployed for two weeks during the month of February, with a focus on Central Avenue and Woodland Avenue.

➤ **Police Volunteers**

Police department volunteers logged 233 hours during the month of February.


Volunteers attended an RSVP awards ceremony and breakfast on February 19<sup>th</sup>. The OVPD VIPS were awarded a Certificate of Appreciation for amassing a total of 19,689.5 hours of volunteer service between 2004 and 2014. The estimated value of a volunteer's time (Delaware) is \$20.29 per hour.

➤ **Arrests**

Officers filed a total of 23 criminal charges and issued 214 traffic citations during the month of February. Additionally, 74 written warnings were issued for traffic violations and 1 DUI arrest was made.

➤ **Police Reports**

During the month of February, officers prepared 34 crime reports, 163 field service reports, and 5 collision reports.
