

## Ocean View Police Department Monthly Report For the June 2015 Town Council Meeting

➤ **Homecoming**

The police department participated in the Town's Homecoming event on May 9th.

➤ **Bike Safety Training**

OVPD teamed up with the Millville Volunteer Fire Company to host a 1-day bike safety workshop on May 19th. DelDOT bicycle and pedestrian safety specialists provided training and resources to assist participants in developing in-house bike safety programs.

➤ **Artisans Fair**

OVPD officers provided traffic control and event security for the Artisan's fair at Lord Baltimore Elementary School on May 23<sup>rd</sup>.

➤ **Speed Trailer Deployment**

The police department's speed trailer was deployed for two weeks on Central Avenue during the month of May.

➤ **Police Volunteers**

Police department volunteers logged 183 hours during the month of May. Additional volunteers are on-staff for the summer -- enhancing the number of hours that the lobby will be open to the public. Chief McLaughlin and the Town Manager hosted a luncheon for the volunteers on May 28<sup>th</sup>.

➤ **In-Service Training**

Officers participated in the following training during the month of May:

➤ **Delaware Police Chief's Seminar**

Chief McLaughlin attended meetings and activities associated with the Delaware Police chief's seminar in Rehoboth Beach during the week of May 18<sup>th</sup>.

➤ **Arrests**

Officers filed a total of 22 criminal charges and issued 197 traffic citations during the month of May. Additionally, 45 written warnings were issued for traffic violations.

During the month of May, officers prepared 52 crime reports, 140 field service reports, and 4 collision reports.
