

Ocean View Police Department Monthly Report For the October 2015 Town Council Meeting

➤ Community Policing Initiatives:

- ✓ On September 2nd, officers participated in Open House activities at Lord Baltimore School.
- ✓ During the week of September 7th, OVPD personnel supported multiple events associated with the Operation Seas the Day initiative.
- ✓ OVPD participated in a national Drug Take Back event on Saturday, September 12th.
- ✓ OVPD will host a Halloween Party on October 24th from 5pm-8pm for local Special Olympic athletes and their families.
- ✓ The Inaugural Cops & Goblins event is scheduled for Saturday, October 31st from 1-pm in John West Park.

➤ Grants:

- ✓ OVPD submitted a special application to the Criminal Justice Council for \$2,018 to support K-9 First Aid training scheduled for February 17-18, 2016. The funds will be utilized to purchase advanced first-aid kits for twenty-five K-9 officers.

➤ Speed Trailer Deployment

The police department's speed trailer was deployed for two weeks during the month of September.

➤ Police Volunteers

Police department volunteers logged 214 hours during the month of September.

➤ In-Service Training

- ✓ September 8-12 – Corporal Bradshaw and Patrolman Caselli attended the TacOps East Conference in Virginia. Corporal Bradshaw received advanced training and instructor certification on Simunitions (scenario-based training). Patrolman Caselli completed a 3-day block of instruction on Tactical Combat Casualty Care.
- ✓ September 16th – Corporal Bradshaw completed a Power Point course at the state police academy.
- ✓ September 21-25th. Chief McLaughlin, Corporal Bradshaw and PFC. Hopkins completed Crisis Intervention Training (CIT).

✓ September 28th – OVPD hosted a MRI Safety Course taught by Beebe Hospital officials.

Officers filed a total of 26 criminal charges, 5 DUI charges, and issued 145 traffic citations during the month of September. Additionally, 26 written warnings were issued for traffic violations.

➤ **New Officer**


Recruit AnnMarie Dalton began training at the State Police Academy on September 14th.


