3. <u>Discussion of the Elementary School Roof Replacement Project</u>

Mr. Jacunski discussed the progress of the roof replacement. The ED049 has been filed with the State of Connecticut. The Plans and Specifications will be presented to the Board of Education on Tuesday for their approval.

Mr. Jacunski researched a question from the last meeting in regards to extended warranties on the gym/300 wing roof. There is a warranty available for purchase after the current warranty expires in 6 years. It is costly, but the committee can revisit the idea at that time.

4. Discussion on Elementary School Boiler Replacement Project

The Plans and Specifications for the Boiler are not complete yet, the Board of Education will have to approve these plans once finished.

5. <u>Discussion on Elementary School Parking Lot Design Project</u>

Mr. Linden discussed the need for test borings of the current parking lot to see the current gravel and sub-base below the pavement. The cost of these borings will be approximately \$8000. The information gained from the results of the borings could save up to \$250,000. Mr. Linden will coordinate scheduling this with the school.
