Committee Reports

- Music on the River (MOR) Ms. Conroy reviewed the plans regarding the criteria for choosing bands. Currently, we get emails and scout online from August through January to determine band choice. The MOR committee looks for a variety of bands, including those that travel internationally rather than local bands that can be seen anytime. MOR continues to grow and we are tentatively \$5000.00 ahead of last year (final numbers to be determined by Finance). The band, "Christine Ohlman & Rebel Montez", was a successful replacement for the cancellation of the previously scheduled band, "Night Flight Final Approach". The 2019 MOR concert series continues to grow and our crowds were a bit larger than last year.
