

**Commission on Aging

Peg Ziobron also sent a letter to the c ommission regarding the problem with the gas stove (smell of gas and the pilot lights going out).

The three people due for renewal of membership were done by the BOS. Coverage for the Senior Center next week is taken care of. Slate of Officers for next year-the Secretary cast one vote and was accepted. A brief discussion of going green was held. The Board of Health is to be contacted by Joanne regarding washing cups and stainless versus sanitizing. The discussion on this will be continued at the next meeting. Stove in Kitchen continues to be a problem with pilot lights going out and smell of gas in the kitchen. The Secretary will send a letter to the Selectmen to follow up on this ongoing problem.

**New Business:**

Joanne Rocznia, coordinator of senior services passed out the activity sheet for May. There were 1110 people for an average of 50 people per day.

Jo Golec thanked the officers for their services for the past two years.
