NEW BUSINESS: A Nominating Committee was appointed, Mary Ellen, John and Rosalie.

Mary Ellen gave a report on Bills passed by the State Aging Commission. Some of then bills are: Training nursing home staff on patients fear of retaliation, a program helping Seniors to stay in their homes, etc.

Total Fitness examined all the exercising equipment and said they are all past their lifetime. They made up a list of equipment needed and the cost. Four machines will cost \$11,350.00 plus \$300.00 for a yearly contract.

Jim asked if we could use the money from the Fund 52, Joanne wasn't sure what the Town would think of that idea.

Joanne said there are two CDs for Aproximately \$5,000.00 each which belong to the Senior Center and there is over \$10,000.00 in the Senior Club checking account. \$4,500.00 of that money belongs to the Senior Center and the rest belongs to the Senior Club. Maybe some of this money could be used. Mary Ellen made a motion that we purchase one treadmill and one recumbent machine for \$4,500.00 and John seconded the motion.

SENIOR COORDINATOR REPORT: Joanne said the numbers per month are basically the same. The Center had 50 tax assistance this year'

No further business to transact, the meeting was adjourned at 11:25AM on the
