ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS APRIL 22, 2010

The public hearing and meeting of the Zoning Board of Appeals was called to order at 8:00 P.M. at the River House by the Chairman, Stuart Wood. Appeal No. 1016 - Michael Moffatt & Mary Beth Mordecai of 1 Lakeview Road, (Property Owners) & Scott W. Jezek, Esq. of P O Box 376, Moodus, (Agent) Michael Moffatt and Mary Beth Mordecai and Scott W. Jezek, Esq. were not present for the public hearing or meeting.

The Chairman stated that both he and the secretary had been contacted by Scott Jezek prior to the meeting and that because of the confusion that has arisen from the way in which the application and the legal notice have been written, they have requested that the application be withdrawn and be reheard at the next meeting scheduled for the fourth Thursday of May.

Greg Daigle made a motion Appeal No. 1016 be withdrawn. Richard Fiala seconded the motion and carried unanimously.

The Chairman suggested that this application be rescheduled and be heard at the May public hearing and the Board waive the application fee. The adjoining property owners will be notified by the appellants at their expense.
