Cardiovascular disease is the leading cause of death in the nation and Connecticut. Approximately 4,500 Connecticut residents die each year due to sudden cardiac arrest. Most of these deaths occur out of the hospital, away from advanced medical assistance and usually happen in the presence of a friend, family member or co-worker.
