The Town of Plymouth Public Works Dept. would like to make the following announcements for the month of April 2017:

APRIL 3, 2017 – **Lane Hill Rd.** will reopen to thru traffic on April 3, 2017 (weather permitting).

APRIL 14, 2017 - Administrative Offices and the Transfer Station will be closed on April 14th, 2017 in observance of Good Friday. The Transfer Station will reopen on Saturday, April 15th, 2017 from 7:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Town Hall administrative offices will reopen on Monday, April 17th, 2017. Recycling will be collected on schedule for the month of April.

APRIL 15, 2017

Brush and Leaf Facility on Tunnel Road will reopen for the season on **Saturdays only** beginning Saturday, April 15, 2017. (Weather permitting)

APRIL 22, 2017

The Town of Plymouth will be hosting a **Household Hazardous Waste Collection** on Saturday, April 22, 2017 in the rear of the Town Hall, 80 Main St., Terryville from 9:00 – 1:00. Collection is open to all residents of Berlin, Bristol, Burlington, Meriden, New Britain, Plainville, Plymouth, Prospect, Southington, and Wolcott. Resident I.D. is required. No waste from businesses will be accepted. Access to the site should be made from Route 72. For additional information, please contact the Public Works Dept. at (860) 585-4030.

APRIL 22 – MAY 6, 2017

Plymouth's "**Amnesty Disposal**" begins on Saturday, April 22nd and will continue until May 6th, 2017. During this period, residents are encouraged to bring bulk items, appliances and tires to the Transfer station for disposal. Residents may drop off bulk items (couches, mattress, box spring), appliances and up to (10) ten tires (passenger/small truck) at no charge.

Demolition material is not included in the program and resident must still obtain a truckload permit at the Public Works Office prior to disposing of materials.

A resident transfer station permit is required to access either facility.
