

Mayor's Covid-19 Update March 19, 2020

This morning I signed a Declaration of Emergency for the Town of Plymouth. I am attaching it to this update for you all to read. This Declaration is a document that is being signed and put into place by all our Mayors and First Selectman from all the cities and towns in our COG (Council of Governments). This declaration will enable us to keep up with emergency needs the second they arise. We are in a situation with this Coronavirus unlike any that we have ever known. It is up to all of us as a community to come together, follow all the health instructions that you have been given and always help each other.

Things here at Town Hall are changing hourly and we are doing everything that we can to keep up and make us as prepared as we possibly can be. Our Emergency Management team is doing an outstanding job.

I will ask you again that you share this information with everyone that you can. It is so important that we all are as informed as possible. Please do your part to limit your visits to Town Hall. Call first to see if we can help over the phone. Take advantage of anything you can do over the internet. Lastly, if it can wait until after this crisis is over, wait. Please respect our Town Hall employees who are doing the best they can during these trying times.

Our Food Pantry will begin soon distributing food to those who have qualified and are in need from the Plymouth Congregational Church. This will be temporary. But if you can also pass this information to anyone that might be in a situation that this will help them.
