The town is asking for about \$11,000,000. A referendum date will not be scheduled until the Mayor hears back from the State. Representative John Piscopo is supporting this project.

Police Chief Karen Krasicky stated the Police Commission is in full support of the building.

Committee Member/Fire Chief Mark Sekorski asked about material increase.

Brian Humes stated there is an ability to adjust the numbers as there is a contingency built in.

The Committee will hold off on the brochure until financial numbers are known.

Committee Member Ann Marie Rheault is working with Connor (webmaster) to have a tab for the Police Building Committee. Minutes, Agendas, Schematics, full study and the link to the video will be posted. The narrative and charge will be added on the home page.

A discussion took place about setting up a separate email and who will be the contact. Linda Schnaars will monitor the emails and she will forward them to the Chairman.

Chairman Mitchell wants the public to know that the Committee has been doing work on this for many months.

Committee Member Ann Marie Rheault went over the Facebook page she created.

Brian Humes will forward brochures from other communities to Committee Member Ann Marie Rheault.

Committee Member Ann Marie Rheault stated that Clem works for the Hometown Foundation and his time that he did to create the video is being donated. They do a lot of work with law enforcement.
