Beautification Committee Vice-Chairwoman Diane Ciano called the February 9, 2022 Beautification Committee Meeting to order at 7:04 p.m. in the Senior Lounge at Plymouth Town Hall, 80 Main Street, Terryville, Connecticut.

Roll Call: Present were: Vice-Chairwoman Diane Ciano, Beautification Committee Member Mary Semon, Beautification Committee Member Jean McMahon, Beautification Committee Member Barbara Huber and Beautification Committee Member Jerry Milne.

Pledge of Allegiance

Beautification Committee Vice-Chairwoman Diane Ciano led the Beautification Committee Members in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Acceptance of Minutes

A motion was made by Beautification Committee Member Jerry Milne, seconded by Beautification Committee Member Barbara Huber, to accept the February 9, 2022 minutes. This motion was approved unanimously.

New Business

a. Permanent tree (Spring project on Arbor Day)

Beautification Committee Member Jerry Milne reported that Gretchen Delcegno, Director of the Terryville Library approached him about planting a tree on behalf of the Rotary Club. They are looking into prices for a spruce tree. Need to get permission from the Church.

b. Tree lighting. Discussion on where the event should be permanently at the Plymouth Green

The committee discussed the parking issue.

Beautification Committee Member Jerry Milne will talk to the Church to see if the event can be held at their location every year.

A discussion took place about the spruce tree and decorating it.

c. Discussion on the town lamps in Terryville

Vice-Chairwoman Diane Ciano reported that the lights are on 24 hours a day. She will reach out to the Mayor Kilduff and tell him the electrician the town uses did not fix the lights. They have been waiting 2 years to get them fixed.

d. Take down of garland

Vice-Chairwoman Diane Ciano emailed Assistant Chief Masi. He is not available this weekend. She will ask him for a date and get back to the Committee.

e. We will need to purchase more containers for the bows and garland that were purchased last year.

A motion was made by Beautification Committee Member Jerry Milne, seconded by Beautification Committee Member Barbara Huber to have Vice-Chairwoman Diane Ciano purchase 5 containers for the extra garland and bows. This motion was approved unanimously.

Other Business

Vice-Chairwoman Diane Ciano stated a new snowman is needed. Will revisit at another meeting.

Beautification Committee Member Mary Semon stated that lights are needed at the waterwheel.

Beautification Committee Member Barbara Huber stated the lights were not working there. Would like a wreath to highlight the waterwheel.

Public Comment None


Board Member Comments
