Minutes

May 11, 2022

Beautification Committee Chairman Randy Olmstead called the May 11, 2022 Beautification Committee Meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. in the Senior Lounge at Plymouth Town Hall, 80 Main Street, Terryville, Connecticut.

Pledge of Allegiance

Beautification Committee Chairman Randy Olmstead led the Beautification Committee Members in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Acceptance of Minutes

A motion was made by Beautification Committee Member Barbara Huber, seconded by Beautification Committee Member Jerry Milne, to accept the April 13, 2022 minutes. This motion was approved unanimously.

New Business

a. Christmas decorations

Beautification Committee Vice-Chairwoman Diane Ciano reported that there is a box of garland in the Mayor's office.

b. Tree at Baldwin Park

Tree at Plymouth Green will be revisited in the future.

Beautification Committee Member Jerry Milne will get pricing on taking down the trees once budget is voted on.

Per the Mayor's office, Beautification Committee Vice-Chairwoman Diane Ciano reported that the bench and garbage pail will not be thrown away. The water is not going to be hooked up as the State is not going to pay for it at Baldwin Park. Planters will be saved as well.

A discussion took place about putting gutters around the gazebo for water for the planters.

c. Update from Congregational Church

d. Planters

Beautification Committee Chairman Randy Olmstead will get the 5 planters at the location by the end of next week – May 21st.

- 2 - Water wheel – each pole
- 1 - Lock Museum

e. Purchasing planters and plants

A motion was made by Beautification Committee Vice-Chairman Diane Ciano, seconded by Beautification Committee Member Jerry Milne to reimburse Beautification Committee Member Pamela Wilson in the amount of \$187.97 for plants for the planters. This motion was approved unanimously.

A motion was made by Beautification Committee Member Pamela Wilson, seconded by Vice-Chairwoman Diane Ciano to reimburse Beautification Committee Member Barbara Huber in the amount of \$170.00 for shrubs for the waterwheel. This motion was approved unanimously.

Other Business

Beautification Committee Vice-Chairwoman Diane Ciano suggested purchasing plants for Memorial Day.

Beautification Committee Member Pamela Wilson suggested buying hanging baskets from Beautification Committee Member Dave Perugini.

Beautification Committee Member Jerry Milne reported he talked to Charlie Wiegert and the Dial-A-Ride buses are available for the tree lighting to shuttle people back and forth. Drivers must have a CDL license.

The Committee will reach out to Beautification Committee Member Joanne Auburn and the fire department regarding drivers with CDL license.

- Jean - Post Office
- Owner of salon - Hairs Inn


