# MEETING MINUTES July 2, 2020 – 3:00 p.m.

<u>Call to Order:</u> Scott Eisenlohr, Chairman & Zoning Enforcement Officer called the July 2, 2020 virtual meeting of the Code Enforcement Committee to order at 3:01 p.m.

<u>Fire Exits</u>: Scott Eisenlohr, Chairman & ZEO made note of the fire exits and explained emergency exit routes to the Committee.

<u>Approval of Minutes</u>: Scott Eisenlohr, Chairman & ZEO entertained a motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting of June 4, 2020.

- a. Property Status List:
- **1. 4 Chidsey Terrace** Chairman Eisenlohr will follow up with the Mayor. The Committee approved the Abatement Plan. Need to send out notice 10 days before any work can be performed.
- **2. 166 Todd Hollow Road** Chairman Eisenlohr went to the property on July 1<sup>st</sup> with the Fire Marshal and Assessor. Will be pursuing faster clean-up of the property.
- **7 Hickory Street** Chairman Eisenlohr reported that a blight letter was issued a while ago. Fees are close to \$10,000. Will be adding \$450 for rats and pest control to the blight lien.
- **4. 130 Fall Mountain Road** A bight letter was issued a couple of weeks ago.
- 5. 293 South Main Street Fees are close to \$10,000. Chairman Eisenlohr will follow up at the next blight meeting.
